What's the Problem?

 Clients have a legitimate expectation when they bet their business needs on you based on an agreement to do something in a certain timeframe, and for a agreed upon price, but circumstances prevent you from coming through

Resolution?

- Own up immediately (in person?)
- Assess reasons:
 - Conflicting interests (clients)
 - Approval process
 - Unanticipated expectations/demands
