This event is designed to be of interest to professionals in surveying, mapping, property assessment, construction and inspection, geology, engineering, mining and similar land-related areas where mapping or identifying what's on the ground is essential. Other areas of applicability: real estate, agriculture, public safety (security & law enforcement; fire & rescue), utilities (distribution and transmission), and aerial photography for a variety of applications.

Program The two-day session begins with a half-day of general sessions and then a series of concurrent one-hour-long breakout sessions. On Saturday morning vendors and speakers will conduct flight demonstrations on the campus airport and answer questions.

What's Included? Continuing education units will be offered (approximately 16 50-minute hours). A light breakfast, lunch, morning and afternoon refreshment breaks are included in the registration fee for both days.
